## **CONDITIONS OF USE YOKINE EAST RESERVE**

**Ref : City of Stirling Letter – Yokine East Reserve dated 20<sup>th</sup> March 2008**

Dear Members

The City of Stirling has accepted our request to use Yokine East reserve for casual flying and has given WARS permission to use the field for six (6) months beginning the 1<sup>st</sup> April 2008 and ending on the 1<sup>st</sup> September 2008.

The Conditions of Use have been dictated by the City of Stirling in a letter to the Club Executive. A copy of the letter is attached for your information and as evidence of written authority.

To fly on Yokine East reserve all members of WARS must abide by the conditions set out by the City of Stirling as well as normal Club & MAAA rules.

**Members must take specific note of the following conditions of use when choosing to fly on Yokine East reserve;**

1. **No flying on East reserve when an organised activity\* is being held.**  
*(\*Organised activity is any official event arranged by other Clubs who have authorised use of Yokine East ie Hockey, Softball and Fishing or Local event approved by City of Stirling).*
2. **No flying on East reserve when there is training or field maintenance being conducted by other Clubs who have authorised use of Yokine East Reserve ie Hockey, Softball and Fishing.**
3. **Under no circumstance is any WARS member to engage in a confrontation with a member of public or member of other Clubs who have authorised use of Yokine East reserve.**

If a member is challenged about flying on the reserve when the conditions of use have been met, then the response is to be;

1. Produce the letter of written authority from City of Stirling.
2. Cease flying if further requested by the public or other user of the field.
3. Notify Ross Cant (0404 634 366) or Michael Patterson (0413 887 149).

The use of Yokine East reserve for casual flying will be monitored by the Club Executive to determine if the Conditions of Use need amendment.

At the end of the trial period, the City of Stirling will review the further use of Yokine East for casual flying, taking into account the performance of the Club during that time when making their decision. It is therefore important that WARS members act responsibly when using the field and maintain a friendly relationship with other users of the reserve at all times. I trust you will enjoy the new opportunities this presents and appreciate your support on this.
